Construction Updates

Construction is underway on the east sides of the 5th floor, 7th floor, and 10th floor of the main tower.

Normal traffic for the 5th floor operating room and waiting area will only be accessible from the Valor elevators. Ambulatory Surgery, Podiatry, and Chemotherapy are still available through the Main tower elevators.

All emergency exit stair wells in the east side of the Main tower will be closed off on the construction floors.


