

VALOR PROGRAM

The VALOR (Veterans Affairs Learning Opportunities Residency) Program is an honors program for select nursing students who have completed the junior year of a BSN ACEN, CCNE, or AACN accredited BSN nursing program. VALOR provides a structured clinical experience with a BSN-prepared preceptor and education course work in a clinical setting. The program consists of a 400-hour experience during the summer months. This program is for those planning a career with the VA. Former VALOR students who become registered nurses working in the VA may be hired at a salary rate above the minimum based on superior qualifications such as documented outstanding performance in the VALOR program and/or or number of hours completed as a VALOR participant.

Special Requirements

- ☆ Students must be U.S. citizens and meet physical examination standards.
- ☆ Students may not be previously obligated to any federal scholarship program, a state or other entity for professional practice following graduation.
- ☆ Students must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale within the previous three years, or based on academic work accepted for credit toward the nursing degree. While a student may have a "C" in a nursing course, the cumulative for nursing course may not be less than a 3.0. Only data on official transcripts should be used for determining grade qualifications.
- ☆ Students must be able to complete a minimum of 400 hours in the program (40 hours/week) between May start date and Sept 30th of this calendar year.
