

GENERAL GUIDELINES ON ELIGIBILITY

- Honorable D/C, General D/C under other than dishonorable conditions, or a d/c under honorable conditions.
- 2 Years of continuous Active Duty Service after 1980
- Service-Connected disabilities, the indigent and those with special health care needs .
- Deployment in Operation Enduring Freedom, Operation Iraqi Freedom, or Operation New Dawn and have “Combat Veteran” designation may enroll for five years following their separation date. (no co-pay for these 5 years) - after 5 years they may apply to enroll as general or financial guidelines with a co-pay.
- Military Sexual Trauma (MST)

The Women's Health Program at the Kansas City VA Honor Annex provides comprehensive primary healthcare for women to include acute and chronic illness, gender-specific, preventive, and mental health care.

Primary Care:

~ Routine detection and management of diseases to the lungs or heart, anemia, cancer detection, diabetes, bone health, and others.

Gender-Specific Primary Care:

~ Contraception counseling

~ Medication issues

~ Management of menopause related concerns

~ Evaluation & treatment of gender-specific conditions such as pelvic and abdominal pain, abnormal bleeding and infections.

~ Mammograms and Pap smears

Preventive Care:

~ Age specific screening

~ Weight management counseling-MOVE!

~ Immunizations

~ Smoking cessation

Mental Health Care:

~ Appropriate screening and referral of military sexual trauma

~ Evaluation and treatment of mental health and/or substance abuse disorders

Referral to Specialty Care:

~ Coordination with a specialty healthcare
